

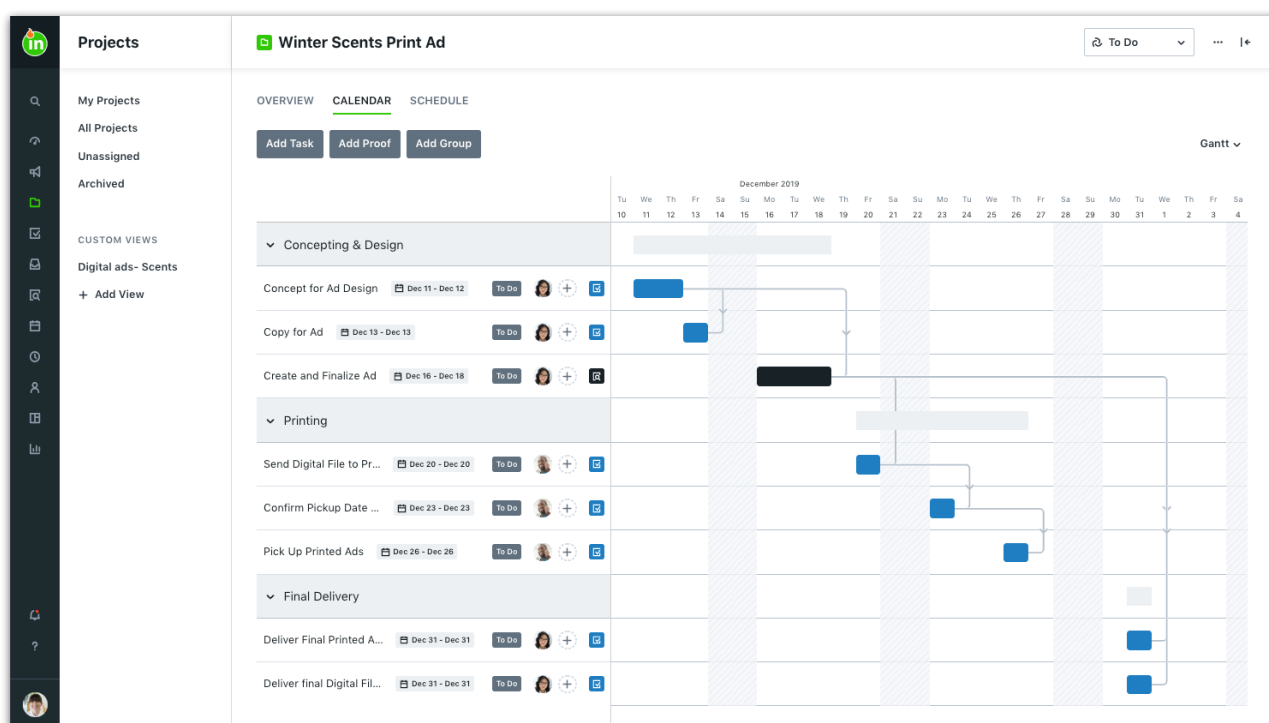

## New Features

### Gantt Views

**Gantt Views** (<http://guide-ignite.inmotionnow.com/help/gantt-view>) give you a dynamic way to view the timeline and dependencies between tasks and proofs within a project. Now it is even easier to identify the impact that adjusting the schedule of work will have on the overall project timeline so teams can manage projects more efficiently to hit deadlines with stakeholders.



### Automatic Date Calculations

Leveraging **Automatic Date Calculations** (<http://guide-ignite.inmotionnow.com/help/automatic-date-calculations>) helps creative teams get started on projects faster by automatically calculating start or due dates for a project based on your specifications in the project template. Automatic Date Calculations are both robust and flexible, allowing teams to customize any workflows, better define SLAs with their stakeholders, and set proper expectations around delivery dates.

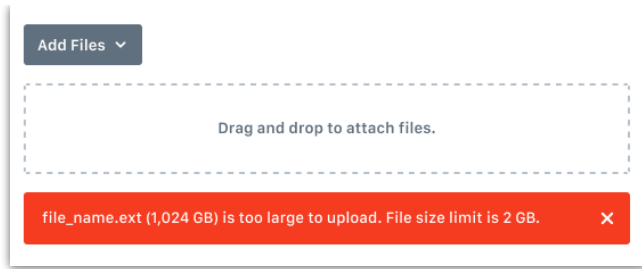
