

Notification Improvements For All!

We know notifications (https://guide-ignite.inmotionnow.com/help/notifications) are important to staying up-to-date on projects and keeping collaboration strong. This latest release allows both core users AND stakeholders(!) to customize their preferences more than ever before.

- You can now view and update both in-app and email notifications at one time with a new page in your
 Personal Settings: Notifications (https://guide-ignite.inmotionnow.com/help/notifications#notification-preferences)
- Stakeholders can also access the Notifications page to update their preferences, includingtime zone
 (https://guide-ignite.inmotionnow.com/help/notifications#time-zone-settings) and frequency (https://guide-ignite.inmotionnow.com/help/notifications#email-frequency)
- Experiencing email overload? Try ournew email digest settings (https://guideignite.inmotionnow.com/help/notifications#email-frequency), now offering frequencies of every 15 minutes and 60 minutes,
 in addition to daily and weekly




Reviews Go Pink

As you know, the work to prepare and manage a proof is different than the task of reviewing! We've decided to start making this distinction clearer within the app. You'll notice a new pink badge that indicates reviews in the main navigation bar, the *My Reviews* list, global search results, report types, and your in-app notifications. We've also made copy and UI updates on the proof modal to help make it even easier to create and send work for review. Some of the changes you'll see include:

- The "Route End Date" is now called the "Review Deadline" and is visible even before you select your reviewers
- The "Proof Subject" is now called the "Review Name"




- The "Send Proof" button now says "Send Proof for Review"
- The "Proof Option" button now says "Review Options"
- The "Proof Assets" header now says "Review Assets"



Even Easier Role Management

When you're setting up your account or making major changes to team roles, full visibility matters. Now you can customize your roles (https://guide-ignite.inmotionnow.com/help/creating-roles) even further and easily view the permissions associated with each role.

- The *Roles* and *Permissions* pages have been consolidated into a single page, *Roles & Permissions*, for an easier way to create and update your team's roles
- You can edit role names and descriptions after the role is created
- The default Stakeholder role is now indicated with a blue badge for improved visibility






Additional Setting Updates



• The General Page in Account Settings is now called Features and boasts a brand new look




• The Profile page in Personal Settings now allows you to manage your avatar, password, assignment preferences, and availability all in one place
